*These are listed as an FYI as there will be optional side trips that SAS plans. These are not required thus cannot be considered in total costs. Every port will offer these opportunities and costs can add up quickly. Some students decide to do all; others do one or two. Students can always sleep on the ship, even when in port. All additional, optional trips, are paid directly to SAS.*

**Important Notes for All Students**

- \* Program fees are subject to change. Semester at Sea's Board of Trustees will confirm spring 2022 rates in May 2021. Students who choose to live in a different cabin will pay those additional fees to Semester at Sea.
- \*\*The fuel fee is subject to change depending on global cost fluctuations. Semester at Sea has the right to make changes to this amount. They will notify you directly if they do. It will be paid directly to SAS and be due 90 days prior to the program beginning.
- \*\*\*Yellow fever vaccine is required for entry into some countries. Please see your current itinerary & discuss with medical professionals. It may not be covered by all health insurance plans and the cost is subject to change. It is also in short supply so you may need to travel to another city to have the shot administered.
- Please note that these **costs are estimated for the term above** and are intended to be used for planning purposes. Costs can fluctuate as a result of changes in exchange rates, tuition or airfare increases & varying personal lifestyles.
- Flight estimate is from UW system preferred travel agency for a similar length of ticket but not the actual dates. There is no guarantee that a similar rate will be available.
- If planning for a future academic year, please add 7%.
- **Optional personal travel** - is not included in this estimate. This cost estimate does NOT take into consideration optional field programs students may sign up for.
- \*Minnesota residents add reciprocity; residents of other states add \$900 in non-resident fees.
