Note: You will take a placement exam when you arrive in Pau. If you are placed in a course that you have already taken, you will be awarded a French elective credit. You are expected to take 4 credits of language in each session. Students at the intermediate level and higher will meet this requirement through a 3-credit language course plus the 1-credit conversation course. In addition, students can enroll in some elective courses. In each session, all students must enroll in a minimum of 4-5 credits and a maximum of 6 credits if they enroll in the Paris Field Study. If the course is only offered in one session, the session is noted in the in the "Term" column.
