Important Notes for All Students:

- *This faculty-led program may receive funding from the Blugold Commitment Faculty-Led International Immersion Experiences (FLIIE) program for all UW-Eau Claire undergraduate students. While students are encouraged to participate in multiple high-impact immersion programs, each student is eligible to receive BCDT funding for only one FLIIE experience. Graduate and non-UWEC students are not eligible to receive this funding.
- **Please note that these **costs are estimated for the term above** and are based on a group of 12 students. They are intended to be used for planning purposes. Costs can fluctuate as a result of changes in exchange rates, participant numbers, tuition or airfare increases & varying personal lifestyles.
- **If planning for a future academic year, please add 7%.**
- Personal expenses address **basic necessities and light to moderate social expenses only.**
- **Optional personal travel** is not included in this estimate.
- Minnesota residents add reciprocity; residents of other states pay non-resident tuition.

Important Notes for Student with Financial Aid

- If you receive financial aid, **only the costs you pay to UWEC will be automatically paid from your aid.** If you receive more aid than what you need to pay to UWEC, you will receive a refund. You are responsible for paying all other costs.
- Be sure to **meet early in the process with Blugold Central (Old Library 1108)** to discuss how much aid you will receive and how your aid will apply to your Immersion program.
