¹Things to do around the Antigua area include

- Valhalla Macadamia Farm in San Miguel Duenas (Q4 bus each way, no entrance fee, includes small tour of the farm where you'll hear all about macadamia nuts, restaurant/cafe and macadamia items for purchase)
- Restaurant and trails in San Cristobal El Alto (taxi or tuk tuk to arrive, prices vary)
- El Pilar natural spring pools in San Cristobal El Bajo and hiking trail (long walk or combo bus/walk or taxi or tuk tuk, spring water filled swimming pools, Q15 entrance fee Q25 for hiking trail)
- Cerro El Tenedor – restaurant and small museums (free shuttle, no entrance fee, restaurant varies)
- Earth Lodge in El Hato (transportation varies, restaurant and activities vary)
- Leatherwork in Pastores (Q3 bus ride?, items for purchase vary)
- Artisan work in San Antonio Aguas Calientes (Q4 bus ride, items for purchase vary)
- Santa Teresita Spa - thermal baths, pool, massage (transportation provided, services starting at \$9)
