**Cost of the Wisconsin Block of Student Teaching**

**\*The cost listed above is only for the international block of your student teaching experience.** Students must also pay for 8 credits of UW-Eau Claire tuition to cover the WI block on their student teaching as well as housing for their time in WI. The 2016-2017 cost of 8 credits for a WI resident is \$2,937.60. The 2017-2018 cost will be available in summer 2017 when it is set by the Board of Regents.
